







Statement of Symptoms and Quarantine.

Pursuant to the Governor of New Hampshire's Emergency Order 27 and 7/2/20 update to NH Lodging Guidelines, all registered guests must attest that they are exhibiting no symptoms of COVID-19. Additionally, registered guests checking in must either provide a Driver's license from NH, ME, RI, MA, CT, or VT as proof of residency or, for other out-of-state guests from non-New England states, attest that they have guarantined at home for 14 days.
