## **Statement of Symptoms and Quarantine**

Pursuant to the Governor of New Hampshire's Emergency Order 27, all registered guests must attest that they are not exhibiting any symptoms of COVID-19. Additionally, registered guests checking in must provide a New England driver's license as proof of residency. For non-New England guests, they must attest that they have quarantined at home for 14 days or for 7 days and then tested and received a negative diagnosis for COVID-19. Approved COVID-19 tests are PCR-based (molecular) tests. Guests cannot have traveled by public transportation.

## **Symptoms Statement (Required by all guests):**

By signing this statement, I attest that no one in my party is currently exhibiting any symptoms of COVID-19 such as:

- 1. Have been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 (**NOTE:** Healthcare workers caring for COVID-19 patients while wearing appropriate personal protective equipment should answer "no" to this question.)
- 2. Fever in the last 48 hours
